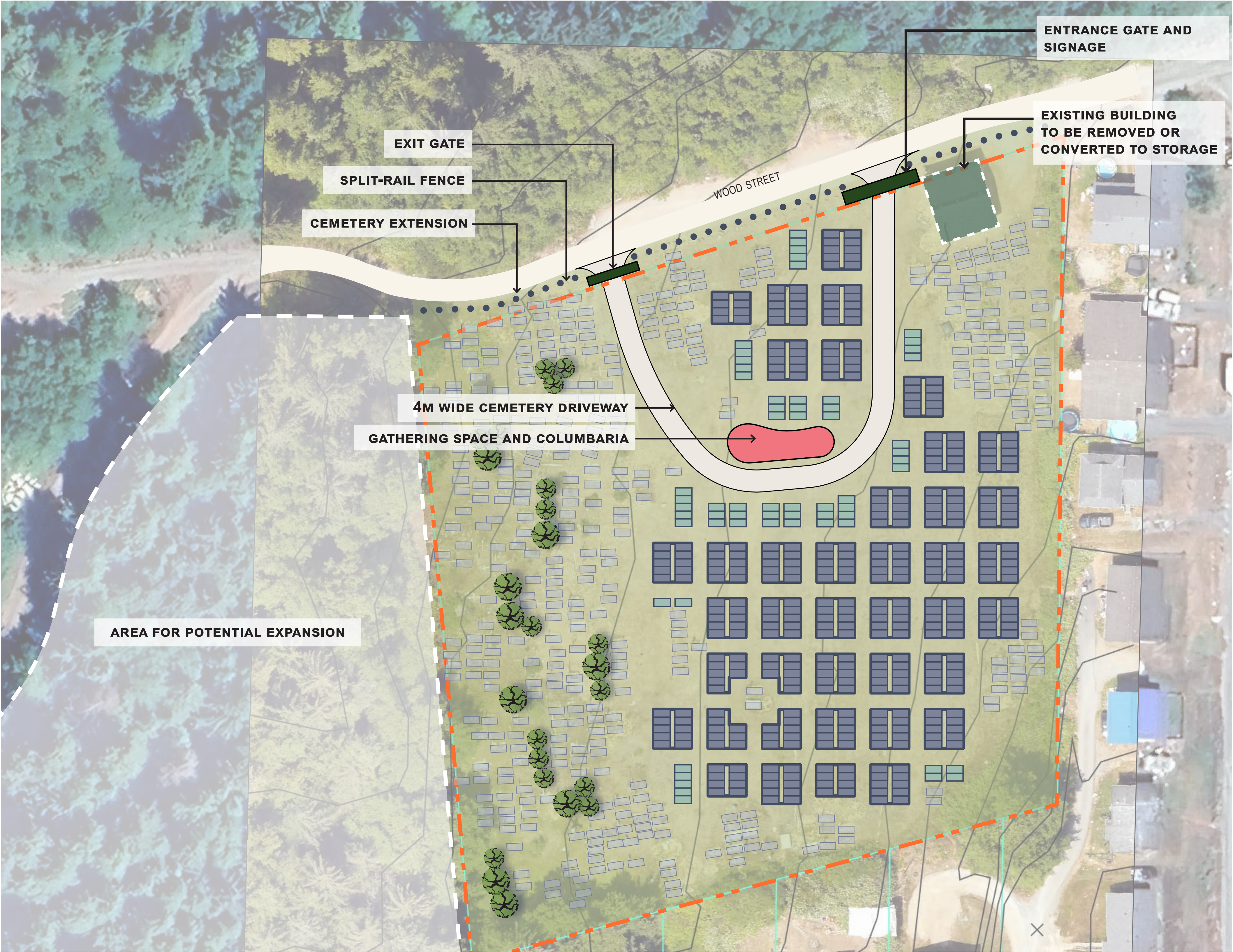
CEMETERY LOCATIONS








PROJECT TIMELINE

-  Enhance the overall landscape appearance of the cemetery through thoughtful additional tree planting.














GATU ROAD CEMETERY CONCEPT



CONCEPT OBJECTIVES

-  Create a cemetery layout that will serve the community for 50+ years.
 -  Create an organized family plot layout that will allow families to reserve lots.
 -  Offer a range of interment options, including cremation burial and columbarium niches.
 -  Establish a clear cemetery boundary that defines the sacred space.
 -  Maintain the existing landscape character by clearing only sections of the existing vegetation.
- Keep a buffer area around the existing Anglican Cemetery to avoid disturbing unmarked graves.

-  Enhance the cemetery landscape with meadow planting and perimeter planting.

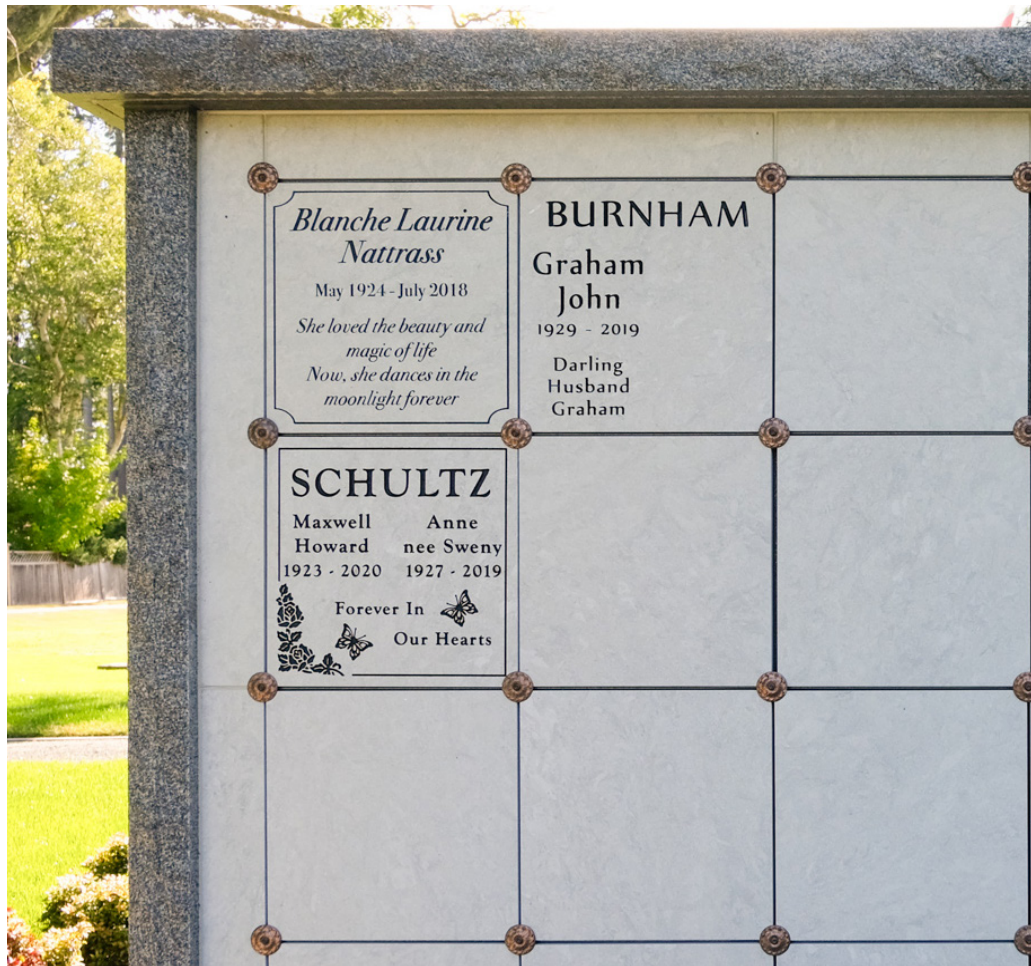
