What Is a Drought?

A **drought** is a period of below-average rainfall that reduces the amount of available water for our homes, environment, and community.

Current Water Conditions

Alert Bay is currently experiencing **Drought Level 2–3** conditions on B.C.'s drought scale.

Water supplies are becoming stressed, and conservation efforts now help protect long-term access to water for households, emergency response, and fire protection.

Why Water Conservation Matters

Alert Bay relies on a groundwater aquifer with a limited supply that is naturally replenished by rainfall.

During extended warm and dry weather, the aquifer cannot recharge as quickly, which can affect our community's long-term water availability.

Recommended Outdoor Watering Schedule

Even-numbered addresses:

Tuesday • Thursday • Saturday

Odd-numbered addresses

Wednesday • Friday • Sunday

5:00 AM – 8:00 AM • 7:00 PM – 10:00 PM
